(5.) III. JOHN APPLETON, [7—1.] b. 1652. It appears by the proceedings of Sir Edmund Andros *vs.* the Town of Ipswich, that he was town-clerk at the meeting on the 23d August, 1687, and some circumstances make it probable that he was the person imprisoned and fined, and not his father, as heretofore stated. He was Deputy to the General Court in 1697, with the title of Lieutenant-Colonel. He was of the Council from 1698 to 1702 ; from 1706 to 1715 ; and from 1720 to 1722.
