

- 232.—*Daniel Pierson*, b. Sept. 14, 1804, in Ellsworth; m. Electa Ann Reed of Sharon Sept. 15, 1828, b. Feb. 18, 1808.
- 233.—*Paulina Pierson*, b. March 15, 1806; m. Ethan Lord of Ellsworth Nov. 20, 1827.
- 234.—*Mary Louisa Pierson*, b. Dec. 11, 1812; m. Augustus L. Peck of Ellsworth Jan. 6, 1841. He died Jan. 22, 1883, of dropsy. She died Sept. 6, 1888; buried in Ellsworth; no children.

Mary Skiff died Nov. 18, 1846, and Freeman Washington Pierson married 2d Miss Maria Boardman, who survived him and died in Bridgewater. He died July 21, 1861, of a shock of palsy; never spoke again. He was five feet ten high, weighed 196, eyes black, hair dark, which he lost by fever and became bald. His breast measure was 42 inches in his old age and after he had lost his flesh. Mary Skiff, mother of all his children, was about five feet four high, weighed 200, blue eyes and dark brown hair. He was a well read, intellectual man and often selectman and constable.

Amideus Pierson died July 31, 1866. His wife died Jan. 13, 1871, aged 86 years, 6 months and 3 days. Both buried in Ellsworth. She was dau. of Richard Miles and Margaret Scott. The Miles, are descended from Richard Miles, who landed in Boston and removed thence to New Haven, Conn. Isabella has two children, daughter Olive and son Harry. Pluma has no children, nor Aurelia M.
