

Pursuant to a commission to us directed from the Hon' John Chandler Esq. Judge of Probate &c for the county of Worster for apprising & dividing the real estate of Joshua Prime late of Sutton dec^d. Said estat lyeth in Sutton in s^d county.

To one hundred thirteen acres of land and buildings apprizd at £251. 13. 10
 Set off to Bridget Prime (said deceased's widow) thirty five acres and one hundred & thirteen pole and buildings apprizd at £83. 16. 10

Said land is buted & bounded as followeth (viz): the first piece containing one acre & eleven pole with the easterly part of the dwelling house, the easterly part of the barn &

Black smith shop thereon, bounded as followeth, beginning at a stake and stones in the yard before the doors & two rod westerly from a mile stone, then North sixteen degrees West through the houss eight rod to a stake & stones, then West sixteen deg^s South two rod & $\frac{1}{2}$ to a stake & stones by the barn yard: then North 26 deg^s West through the medle of the barn 6 rod to a stake & stones; then westerly about two rod to rod to the road; then northerly about 10 rod by the s^d road to a heap of stones at Willis Hall's land; then easterly by s^d Hall's land thirteen rod to a heap of stones; then South 3^o East 11 rod & $\frac{1}{2}$ to a stake & stones; then South 25^o east 6 rod to a stake & stones at the country road; then westerly by said road 7 rod & $\frac{1}{2}$ to the bounds first mentioned.

The second piece containing 25 acres & 62 pole lying on the south side the contry road and the easterly side of the south lot. Beginning at a heap of stones at Willis Hall's land; then southerly bounding on said Hall's part & part on Stephen Hall's land 150 rod to a stake & stones; then westerly by Edmund Peters land 27 rod to a stake and heap of stones; then north 33^o West 152 rod by land set off to the heirs of s^d dec^d to a stake & stones at s^d country road; then easterly by s^d road about 28 rod to the bounds first
